प्रोरणा मोलाहेड़ा की चौपाल से शुरू किया बच्चों को पढ़ाना

दुकान पर काम करने वाला अरविंद अब १५० बच्चों को कर रहा

एक वक्त था जब धर का खर्च चलाने के लिए पिता के साथ दुकान पर मजदूरी करता था। जिस उम्र में हाथ में किताबें होनी चाहिए थीं उस उम्र में कंधों पर धर खर्च का बोझ था। इस दौरान एक व्यक्ति की नजर मुझ पर पड़ी और उसने मुझे दुकान के काम से बाहर निकालकर मेरे हाथ में किताबें थमा दीं। मेरा पूरा खर्च उठाया और आज मैं न केवल शिक्षा पा कर रहा हूं, बल्कि 150 गरीब बच्चों को शिक्षित भी कर रहा हूं। यह कहानी है मोलाहेड़ा निवासी अरविंद सक्सेना की। अरविंद अब बीकॉम फाइनल ईयर के छात्र हैं और मोलाहेड़ा की चौपाल पर 150 बच्चों को शिक्षा देते हैं।

2005 से शुरू की पढ़ाई

22 साल के अरविंद ने बताया कि 2005 में पिता के साथ फुटवियर की शॉप पर काम करते थे। घर के



आर्थिक हालात ठीक नहीं थे। इसके चलते पढाई नहीं कर पा रहा था। साल 2009 में प्रनीत सुशील नाम के एक व्यक्ति ने मुझे दुकान पर काम करते देखा तो अपनी संस्था प्रयत्न के साथ जोड़कर मुझे शिक्षा दिलवाना शुरू कराई। पहले उन्होंने मुझे खुद पढ़ाया और प्राथमिक रूप से शिक्षित कर करने के बाद मेरा एडमिश्न सरकारी स्कूल में पांचवीं क्लास में करा दिया। स्कूल के साथ-साथ वो मेरी पढ़ाई पर खुद ध्यान देते लगे। कुछ समय बाद प्रनीत सुशील के साथ मिलकर मैंने भी आसपास रहने वाले लोगों से संपर्क किया और

यहां बच्चों को शिक्षा प्राप्त करने के प्रेरित किया। इसके बाद मैं संस्था के साथ वालिटियर के तौर पर जुड़ गया और अपने आसपास के क्षेत्र में सर्वे कर उन बच्चों को ढूंढा, जिनमें शिक्षा की अलख जगानी थी। सर्वे में 7 बच्चे ढूंढ निकाले और उन्हें गांव की चौपाल में ही शिक्षा देने लगा। अपनी पढाई के साथ बच्चों को पढाने का मौका मिलने लगा।

शुरुआत में बच्चों को जुटाने में हुई दिक्कत

अरविंद ने बताया कि शुरुआत में बच्चों को जुटाने में काफी परेशानी हुई। परिजनों के विरोध का सामना करना पड़ा, लेकिन जब बच्चों में शिक्षा के प्रति ललक देखी तो उनके परिजन भी उन्हें रोक नहीं पाए। आज मोलाहोड़ा में ही 150 छात्रों को पढ़ा रहा है। खुद दिल्ली यूनिवर्सिटी से बी कॉम फाइनल ईयर की पढ़ाई कर रहा हं। साथ ही दिल्ली से सीए की पढ़ाई भी कर रहा हूं।
